Welcome to the 5th edition of **FORWARD! (Forward!25 Fall Edition)**, a pre-acceleration program designed to take your startup from the ideation phase to a **prototype** and continue your journey toward building something that attracts investors!

For the second time, the program is open to all students and alumni from **Universidade Católica Portuguesa**, regardless of their faculty—whether you're studying Law, Medicine, Business, or any other discipline.

The program combines **hands-on workshops, expert mentorship, and intensive pitch practice**, with a strong focus on prototype development. Sessions will be a mix of **in-person** meetups at Católica and **online** sessions, ensuring flexibility while fostering strong community connections among entrepreneurs.

Selection Process

Our team will review applications based on the depth of responses, focusing on your team's willingness, grit, and potential to bring an idea to market.

During this program each team will have access to a pool of mentoring hours. On Demo Day, a jury composed of incubator managers will assess the final pitches.

Do I need a business plan?

Nope! Just bring your idea and your passion.

Will you sign an NDA to protect my idea?

No, we don't sign NDAs at this stage. The commitment to secrecy on our application form is more than any VC would offer at this stage, and we take confidentiality seriously.

We have two ideas—should we submit two applications?

We recommend you pick your favorite idea and apply with that one. Focus on one, and make it shine!
